### AWARDS AVAILABLE:

#### Speed World Challenge GT

##### Chassis system usage awards:

Use of "Complete" GR40 Chassis system consists of everything listed in any combination of parts found on our website for complete chassis systems. In other words you need a Torque Arm, a Panhard bar or Watts Link, a K member, front and rear lower control arms, GR40/Koni coil over shocks and struts, GR40 subframe connectors and or frame kits, etc. If we manufacture it and a competitor in the market place makes a copy or like unit, it can't be on your car to be eligible. If you have any questions regarding your eligibility contact us.



##### Individual main event awards:

- ❖ \$1000 Cash for first place, plus \$250.00 in purchasing credits
- ❖ \$ 500 Cash for second place, plus \$250.00 in purchasing credits
- ❖ \$ 250 Cash for third place, plus \$250.00 in purchasing credits
- ❖ \$1000 Cash per pole position.

Speed World Challenge Championship participants will receive purchasing credits as follows:

- ❖ Top 5                \$1000   or \$500.00 cash
- ❖ Top 10              \$500    or \$250.00 cash

##### Use of Griggs Racing Individual Products:

If a "Complete GR40 Chassis system" is not in use, But GR40 chassis components are in use on the car, and no other chassis component manufacturer's decal is present the following purchasing credit awards will be presented to the following finishing positions in any main race event:

- ❖ First                \$100.00
- ❖ Second             \$50.00
- ❖ Third                \$250.00

### **Use of GR40 engine assembly:**

A “GR40 Engine assembly” is a complete new long block with oil pan, pump (wet or dry sump), with intake manifold, built dyno tested and tuned by Griggs Racing to GR40 specifications for the particular class.

Push Rod engine (Chevrolet or Ford):

- ❖ \$2500 cash rebate the first season after purchase of a complete GR40 Engine assembly for finishing first in the Championship points.
- ❖ \$500.00 cash rebate for the first win in the first season with a new GR40 Engine assembly.

Ford Modular 32v engine:

- ❖ \$5000 cash rebate the first season after purchase of a complete GR40 Engine assembly for finishing first in the Championship points.
- ❖ \$1000.00 cash rebate for the first win in the first season with a new GR40 Engine assembly.

### **Qualification:**

- ❖ Since contingency awards depend on your effort to help us sell our products by your using them, you must sign up at least 7 days before running your first event as a GR40 awards participant, and you may do so by downloading the contingency form on our website and emailing it to [bg@griggsracing.com](mailto:bg@griggsracing.com).
- ❖ A driver/team biography with pictures of car and driver suitable for publication.
- ❖ Griggs Racing contingency decals must be prominently displayed front and rear and both sides, clearly visible in photos. These may be obtained from respective race officials or directly from Griggs Racing. You must also have your photos sent to us before you run your second event. Photos must be in tiff or jpeg format, and be at least 11x22 at a minimum 72dpi or no smaller than 4x7 at 300dpi.
- ❖ All awards will be available for redemption no sooner than 30 days after last event of season, and must be redeemed within 180 days of season’s end. Griggs Racing is not responsible for notification to participant as to awards qualification.
- ❖ It is entirely up to the participant to claim any award due, and provide evidence of compliance with verification from the properly designated race official.
